

## **Clint Bowyer Looking for a Good Finish at New Hampshire Motor Speedway**

### **This Week's Cheerios/Hamburger Helper Chevrolet at New Hampshire Motor Speedway**

Clint Bowyer will pilot Chassis No. 265 from the Richard Childress Racing NASCAR Sprint Cup Series stable. Built new for 2009, this Chevrolet debuted at Atlanta in March, where Bowyer recorded a sixth-place finish, followed by a 36th-place finish at Lowe's Motor Speedway in May.

#### **New Hampshire Facts**

Bowyer's average running position of 14.813 ranks him 13th best at NHMS. His Driver Rating of 89.1 ranks him 12th best among the 59 drivers who have competed at the "Magic Mile" over the last four years. In seven NSCS starts at NHMS, Bowyer has one win, an average starting position of 15.6 and an average finish of 20.4.

#### **Rearview Mirror**

Bowyer and his Shane Wilson-led Cheerios/Hamburger Helper team were able to lean on their Richard Childress Racing teammates to overcome handling woes in the opening half of the Chevy Rock & Roll 400, giving them what they needed to rally to a sixth-place finish last Saturday night at Richmond International Raceway.

#### **Get to the Points**

Bowyer's sixth-place finish at RIR last week advanced him one position, to 15th, in the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series point standings. Out of the Chase field, the race for 13th place is on. Bowyer trails the current position holder, Kyle Busch, by 136 markers.

#### **Through 26 Races**

Over the season's first 26 races, Bowyer has accumulated four top-five and 11 top-10 finishes, an average start of 18.4 and an average finish of 16.2. The two-time NSCS winner has led 40 laps of competition and has completed 7,003 of the 7,336 (95.5 percent) laps contested thus far.

#### **New Hampshire Rewind**

Bowyer appeared to be in contention for a top-10 finish at New Hampshire Motor Speedway when the series last raced there in June, but rain came at an inopportune time, crediting him with a 20th-place finish.

#### **Catch the Action**

The SYLVANIA 300 from New Hampshire Motor Speedway will be televised live Sunday, Sept. 20 beginning at 1 p.m. EDT on ABC and broadcast live on the Performance Racing Network and Sirius XM Satellite Radio. Qualifying for the 27th of 36 NASCAR Sprint Cup Series events will take the green flag at 3 p.m. EDT Friday, Sept. 18 and will be telecast live on ESPN2.
